






Space-saving concepts ensures that the allocated space is utilised fully in ingenious ways.





LOFT DESIGN CONCEPT

This interior design project shows our Designer – Mavis Tan's expertise in utilizing the space fully according to the needs of the homeowner for all areas of her home. Seeing that the homeowner's residence has a high ceiling, Mavis took advantage of the height by using the loft design concept. For all three bedrooms in the house, the beds are placed above the study room to ensure that there is ample space for the homeowner and her family members to move around as well as to store other belongings and furniture.

For the main living area, the homeowner specially requested for the space to be more spacious so that her daughter will be able to practice ballet there more conveniently. Hence, Mavis designed the area to resemble a ballet studio, featuring long glass mirror panels and minimal furniture for the daughter to move about freely and safely. Moreover, pullout drawers and cupboards were brilliantly utilized in the place of traditional cabinets. This enables the homeowner to have ample storage without needing to install space-consuming cupboards and furniture.

OPEN CONCEPT KITCHEN A MODERN TREND

To match the overall aesthetics of the entire home, Mavis suggested for the homeowner to have an open concept kitchen – a current trend amongst newer homes today. The open kitchen allows the homeowner and her loved ones to have uninterrupted view from the living space to the dining area, right up to the kitchen. This enables the entire space to look more spacious and comfortable.



Q: What are some of the features and your values to customer for being a U-Home Interior Designer?






Q: What are some of the features and your values to customer for being a U-Home Interior Designer?
